Our overall mission is to provide veterans with support and fellowship resulting from sharing outdoor

recreational activities with other veterans and patriotic minded volunteers.

Our organization is governed by a Board of Directors consisting of veterans, past participants, and passionate volunteers. We are our own, mission oriented, 501 (c) 3 nonprofit organization. MWOTW was formed in 2015 with the help of Montana Walleyes Unlimited. We continue to receive support from this statewide organization, as well as, from several local Chapters. As an allvolunteer organization, many people donate many hours, money, and resources in giving back to our veterans.

Annually, we provide an all-expense paid, week long fishing trip on Fort Peck Lake in eastern Montana at the Hell Creek State Park and Marina near Jordan, MT and at the Fort Peck Marina near Glasgow, MT. We solicit applications annually allowing the Board of Directors to review and select veterans who are able to attend the



summer fishing event for that vear. While all the veterans that apply are worthy of selection, we are only able to take

between 12-18 veterans due to logistics and limited budget. Veterans are selected from all across the country and always include Montana veterans.

Through landowner, outfitter or individual

donations, we have been given the opportunity to provide bird hunts, antelope, deer and elk hunts, as well as, smaller fishing trips. We have taken many veterans

hunting all over Montana including several men and women vets hunting cow elk near Big Timber.



We have had the honor of having Purple Heart recipients come join us and be able to harvest their first ever elk. We will continue to offer hunts for Purple Heart recipients as our funds allow.

We have also been able to take youths on their very first deer hunt accompanied by their veteran fathers and we certainly want to continue to honor our military families by offering these type of bonding experiences.



We have had many land owners, guides and individuals offer us other hunting and fishing opportunities



all over Montana and we hope to be able to take advantage of these kind offers as this organization grows. We are only as good as those that support us!

Our goal is to have

our veterans form lifelong friendships and relationships that will stand the test of time and distance. We believe one of the greatest testaments to our organization is that we have past participants ask to return as volunteers the next year using their own funds to do so. We have welcomed back many of them in exactly that way. They are there for each other,
